

Try one thing: Using your camera phone

Magnification

Bigger text is often **easier to read**. It's easy to make text bigger, simply by using your phone by just pointing the camera at the text.

Depending on your phone, just moving it closer to the text will make the text bigger on the screen. Or you can hold your phone further back and use 'pinch zoom' on the screen. If holding the phone still when the camera is zoomed in is difficult, take a photo of the text instead. You can then zoom in on the photo without having to hold the phone still.

Scanning QR codes

A QR code is a special kind of black-and-white square made up of tiny boxes and dots. Machines, like smartphones, can scan the code, turning it into something we can read.

One common use is to help people get to a website without needing to read and type a long website address. Just point your camera at the code, then **tap the website address** that appears on the screen.

You should always check that the website you're taken to is the one you were expecting. Scammers can use QR codes to send people to fake websites.

Some newer phones can automatically scan QR codes. But if nothing happens when you point your camera at a QR code you may need to install an app first. Search your app store for 'QR code scanner'.
